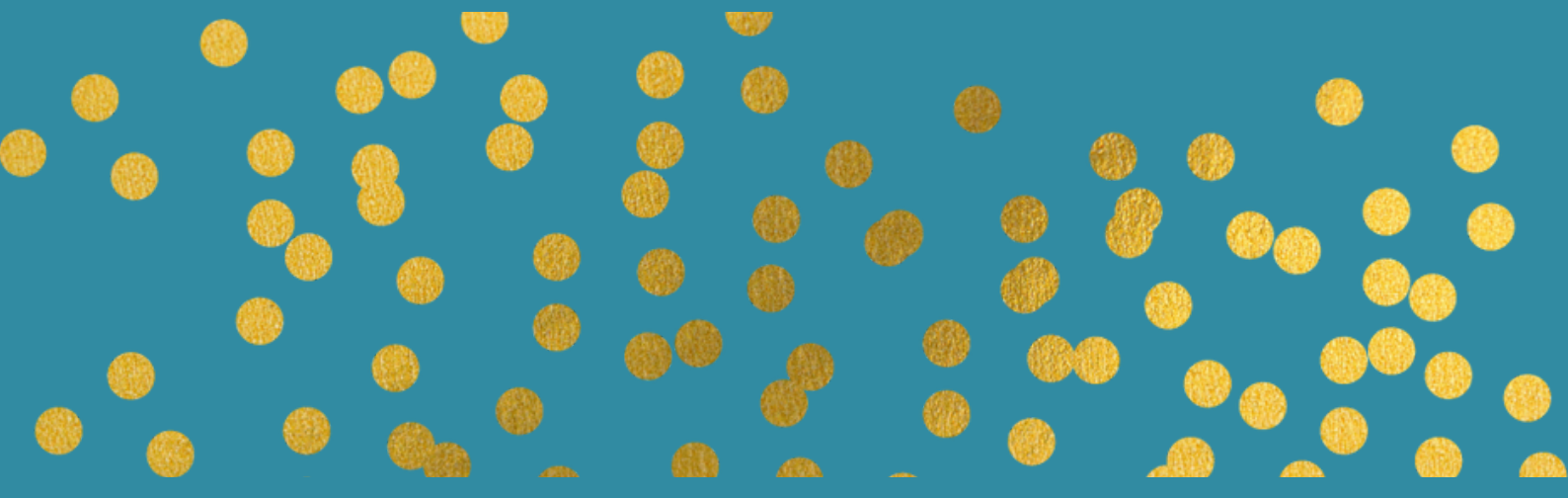

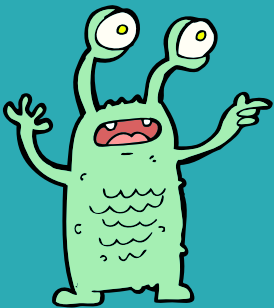
What do you think some of the ground rules and rights of our group should be?

What are your hopes for our work together?

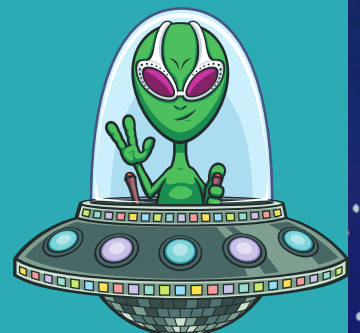
The group has decided to create a music and spoken word piece. Who is it important to share it with afterwards? Who needs to know what you have to say?
